



Brigadier General **Antonios Theodosiades** was born at Alexandroupoli, in 1968. He was admitted to the Hellenic Army Military Academy in 1986 and graduated in 1990 as 2nd Lieutenant, Armor.

As a junior officer, after completing his basic training as an Armor Officer, he served initially as instructor and platoon leader at the Hellenic Armor School and the training battalions of the Armor Center. Afterwards he served in various Armor Battalions, as tank platoon leader and tank company commander. He also served as Military Police company and battalion commander, and as Staff Officer in the NATO HQ Joint Command South (HQ JSRCS) in Verona, Italy.

Following his graduation by the Hellenic Joint War College, as senior officer, he served as Ops-Plans Staff Officer, Armor Btn Deputy Commander, Training Staff Officer, G4 Chief and later as Armor Btn Commander, in various Brigade level, operational HQs and Armor Units. As senior officer he also served, as Staff Coordinator Operations at the Multinational CIMIC Group (HQ MNCG) in Motta di Livenza, Italy. Later he served as Armor Brigade HQ Chief of Staff, as Military Police Director at the Hellenic Army General Staff/MP Directorate and finally as Commandant of the Hellenic Armor School.

During his career, he commanded the 957th MP Company, the 957th MP Battalion, the 25th Tank Battalion and the Hellenic Armor School.

In 2020, he was promoted to Brigadier General and assigned to the Hellenic Army General Staff as Director of the Military History Directorate (HAGS/MHD).

He has attended all required Armor Officers' training courses, the Battalion Maintenance Officers Course (BMOC) at the US Army Armor School in Fort Knox, KY. He has also attended the MP Officers Basic Course at the Hellenic MP Training Center, the Hellenic Army Staff Officers School and the NATO Staff Officers Orientation Course at NSO. He is a graduate of the Hellenic Joint War College; the Program on Terrorism and Security Studies (PTSS) of the "George C. Marshall" European Center for Security Studies and the Hellenic National Defense College (HNDC).

He holds a Master diploma, in Geopolitical Analysis, Geostrategic Synthesis, Defense and International Security Studies, by the Department of Turkish and Modern Asian Studies, School of Economics and Political Science of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens.

Brigadier General Antonios Theodosiades, has been awarded all decorations, commendations and medals, provided for his rank.
